COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

- Each member can enter up to 2 projected images in the relevant PDI competition. Each image can be either colour or monochrome.
- The maximum size for projected images is 1400 pixels wide x 1050 pixels high in jpeg format. Please send in the sRGB colour space to ensure optimum image quality when projected.
 Each file should be clearly labelled to identify the photographer.
 - Projected Image files for club competitions must be submitted either on disc, memory stick or by email by the deadline advised by the internal competition secretary.
- 4. Each member can enter up to 4 prints in the relevant print competitions (comprising of no more than 2 prints in colour and 2 prints in monochrome). The top scoring relevant entry in each competition will count towards the "Veale Shield" (colour), the "Bingham Shield" (monochrome).
- 5. The maximum mount size for all prints is 50cm x 40cm.
- 6. Any projected image or print that has been used in an internal competition cannot be used in another internal competition other than in the 'Projected Image of the Year' or 'Print of the Year' competitions. However a projected image or print used in external competitions is eligible for internal competitions.

COMPETITION TROPHIES FOR 2023

PHOTOGRAPHER OF THE YEAR

Awarded to the club member who has the highest cumulative score of their top scoring entry in each monthly competition throughout the calendar year and having had at least one entry in all 3 categories:

Projected Image, Monochrome Print and Colour Print.

Awarded for second place in the above competition.

Awarded for third place in the above competition.

PROIECTED IMAGE OF THE YEAR TROPHY

Awarded to the winner of the annual Projected Image of the Year competition.
